Welcome to this week's announcements today being the **22nd Sunday in ordinary time.**

Morning mass takes place from *Tuesday to Saturday @ 6.30 a.m. at St. Jude Parish.*

Every Saturday - Confessions at the grotto from **4.30 p.m** - *St. Jude Parish.*

- 1. CATECHIST:** - Catechism classes for school going children take place every **Saturday from 11.00 a.m to 1.00 p.m** for sacraments of baptism and FHC whereas confirmation classes go on from **1.30 p.m to 4 .00 p.m on Saturdays.**
 - The adult classes take place every **Sunday after the second mass.** All those who wish to be baptized and those who are baptized but don't receive eucharist can register with the catechist for classes.
 - Also those joining the Catholic church from other churches are encouraged to register for classes.
 - The infant Baptism classes will go on today after the second mass.
 - Confessions for the catechumen being prepared for the sacrament of confirmation will take place next Saturday from **8.00 a.m. (St. Jude Parish)**

- 2. SACRED HEART DEVOTION GROUP:-** Will have a night vigil this coming Friday **2nd of September.** They will begin with confessions at **7.00 p.m** and mass will start at **7.30 p.m** followed by adoration throughout the night. All are welcome. (**@ St. Jude Parish**)

- a. *On 10th September 2022, there will be celebration of St. Jude family day at St. Jude Parish. We shall have confirmation and the celebrant will be His Grace Archbishop Philip Anyolo. In this view you're all requested to prepare and plan adequately for the day. (St. Jude Novena to start on Thursday 1st September)*

- b. *During the family day, those who wish to come with their individual offertory/gifts (matega) should consider dry food, sanitary towels and cooking oil as gifts for that day. The items will be used to support some charity homes.*

- c. *The high mass during the St. Jude family day will start at 10.00 a.m, all are encouraged to be in their respective group uniforms and those not in any groups should put on the St. Andrew T-shirts as we celebrate as a family.*
